Ensure that your CV makes clear that you are 'career-young' i.e. have not been employed as a biometrician for more than five years. Bursary applicants must be members of the British and Irish Region of the IBS and employed or studying in the UK or Ireland at the closing date. Applications should be submitted by email to Sue Welham (stats4biol@gmail.com) by 31st Jan 2017 and applicants will receive a decision by 28th Feb 2017. The award is contingent on your abstract being accepted for oral or poster presentation and your attendance at the conference. You will be expected to submit a report on your attendance at the conference and its benefits for young biometricians.
